HB170	Rep. Ellebracht (Clay county)	1/07/2021 - Read Second Time (H)	Provides that a person may be charged with promoting a suicide attempt or voluntary manslaughter if such person is convicted of abusing certain persons and such conduct significantly contributed to the suicide or suicide attempt
HB304	Rep. Kelley (Jade, Barton, Jasper, Cedar counties)	2/4/2021 - Referred: Elementary and Secondary Education	Enacts requirements relating to suicide prevention education and information
HB437	Rep. Appelbaum (St Louis county)	2/4/2021 - Referred: Elementary and Secondary Education	Enacts requirements relating to suicide prevention education and information
HB465	Rep. Pike (Vernon, Bates counties)	4/7/2021 – House hearing 8:00am. You can watch online	Enacts requirements relating to suicide prevention education and information
SB515	Sen. Gannon (Iron, Reynolds, St. Francois, Ste. Genevieve, Washington, part of Jefferson County)	3/4/2021- Second Read and Referred S Education Committee	Modifies provisions relating to continuing education in youth suicide awareness and prevention for teachers
